



Eid , Urs arrangement reviewed in Kishtwar

Kishtwar, Jun 06: District Development Commissioner, Angrez Singh Rana , today convened a meeting of all the district officers to review arrangements for upcoming festival of Eid ul Fitar and Urs Shah Farid-ud-Din Baghdadi falling on 15th of June 2018 and 20th of June respectively.

SSP Abrar Ahmed Chowdhary, ADDC Imam Din, CPO Yasir Balwan, ACR Inderjeet Parihar, ACD Anil Chandail and district officers besides members of Muslim Shouri Committee and Administrator Auqaf islamia attended the meeting.

During the meeting, the DDC discussed in detail the arrangements being put in place by the administration for smooth conduct of the religious festival.

SSP was asked to ensure proper security management in the town especially around Eidgahs while the Army (RR) was asked to arrange the tents at Eidgah (Chowhan ground) to facilitate the Eid prayers.

PHE department was asked to ensure adequate supply of water in the town with few points at Eidgah besides they were asked to ensure safe drinking water for devotees at the shrines of Astan Bala and Astan Paien.

To ensure hassle free movement of devotees in and around the shrine especially during late hours the job of repair and replacement of non- functional street lights in the town and Chowghan were assigned to Chief Executive Officer Kishtwar Development Authority and Executive Officer Municipality Kishtwar .

Mr Rana also informed that the devotees are pouring in from different parts of the country for the Urs festival and asked for adequate facilities and proper management of traffic in the Town.

ARTO Kishtwar was directed to ensure sufficient deployment of buses for the smooth to and fro movement of devotees during Urs Mubarak

DDC further issued directions for the activation of market checking squads and directed them to intensify the checking of quality ,quantity and prices of essential commodities supplied to the consumers.

Instructions were also given to Executive Engineer PDD Kishtwar for maintaining un- interrupted power supply to both the shrines and town.

To tackle any medical emergency CMO Kishtwar was impressed upon to keep the ambulance along with medical team ready at both the shrines and at the places thronged by the devotees.

Arrangements regarding the Stock and supply of ration, LPG Cylinders, firewood, construction of temporary toilets during Urs Mubarak were also reviewed and necessary directions were passed to the concerned.
