

DM Kishtwar constitutes Flying Squads for IGNOU examination Centers

District administration serious to curb the menace of mass copying in examination centers

Kishtwar, Jun 09: Keeping a proper surveillance on the menace of copying in the examination at IGNOU centers functioning in district Kishtwar at various Institutions, Deputy Commissioner Kishtwar, Angrez Singh Rana constituted different teams of Gazetted officers for keeping check up in and around the examination centers of Indira Gandhi National Open University including GDC Kishtwar, Chatroo and Government Girls high School Padder.

"In order to prevent outside interference and disturbance in each examination hall, restrictions under section 144 Cr.Pc have already been imposed vide order no 555-64/DM/K dated 02-06-2018 and despite imposition of restrictions there are reports that in past mass copying have been occurring in these examination centers", the order of DM reads.

Meanwhile, the teams constituted as flying squad for three examination centers in District Kishtwar including Assistant Commissioner Revenue and ZEO Kishtwar (GDC Kishtwar), Sub District Magistrate and ZEO Chatroo (GDC Chatroo) and SDM Padder and ZEO Padder (Government Girls High Secondary School Padder) have been deputed for the proper surveillance of examination centers.

Moreover, the members of the flying squad are directed to conduct the surprise visits in the examination centers and take stern action to stop the menace of mass copying.

They were further directed to submit progress report to the district administration on daily basis till the examination is over.

The superintendents of Chatroo and Padder examination centres have been directed to deposit the answer sheets parcels with the post master Kishtwar instead of Chatroo and Padder
